



Hi there. We hope you enjoyed the basic sailing class you recently took, run by **SEAS Monmouth**. We'd like to give you some more information about our club, and highlight some of the benefits you receive as a member:

ACCESS TO OUR SAILING FLEET:

- ◆ 2 16'-17' daysailers at Marina Bay Club on the Shrewsbury River
- ◆ A 22' Rhodes at Fair Haven Yacht Works on the Navesink River
- ◆ A 28' O'Day with inboard diesel at Perth Amboy Municipal Marina on the Raritan Bay
- ◆ A fleet of Lasers that are brought out for small boat days and special events
- ☀ The daysailers, Rhodes, and O'Day all have scheduled activity sails each week where members can sail with a club skipper. Any member can join one of our evening sails, and a minimal trip donation is requested to help in the upkeep of our fleet.
- ☀ Upon qualifying as skippers, members can apply for keelboat passes that allow them unlimited access to the boats during the course of the season at a reasonable cost.
- ☀ SEAS hosts a number of other events and weekend activities on our boats including Raft-ups, Weekend sails, and Small Boat Days.

GREAT EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES:

- ☀ As you know, we teach a **Basic Sailing Course** throughout the season to new sailors.
- ☀ We offer classes for more advanced sailors such as a **Cruising course** which takes place over a three day weekend sail in the Chesapeake Bay, a **Boat Handling course** which emphasizes how to maneuver a boat under power, and an **Advanced Sailing course**.
- ☀ We also run single-evening "**mini-courses**" that can give you further perspective on topics like engine maintenance, man-overboard drills, and docking and maneuvering.

GET TO KNOW YOUR FELLOW SAILORS:

- ☀ On the last Tuesday of every month, we host interesting speakers at our general meetings which are held at 7:30 PM at the Colts Neck Inn in Colts Neck.
- ☀ We host a series of parties throughout the year at the Monmouth Beach Cultural Center.
